

Help Wanted


We are looking for volunteers to help with Front of House for "Totally 80's". We require two ushers (showing people to their seats) and one programme seller on any of the following dates;

ROLES AVAILABLE

Eva Peron

Determined and enterprising woman who cunningly advances from her small town existence to the heights of political and social power. She becomes beloved by the people who affectionately call her "Evita".

o Mezza

o *Age range: 20-25*

Lead role

Che

The narrator, Che is the charismatic, passionate, hopeful yet cynical guide through the events of Evita's life. As he narrates, he is present in many scenes, playing different "roles" to provide insight, criticism and commentary from a variety of perspectives.

o Tenor

o *Age range: 21-35*

Lead role

Juan Peron

Ambitious military figure who is initially ousted from power and then elected President of Argentina in 1946 and creates a powerful government administration with Evita's help.

o Baritone

Age range: 32-55

Lead role

Magaldi

Tango musician who is Evita's first love interest. He is her "ticket" from small town life to the excitement and possibility of Buenos Aires.

o Tenor

Age range: 23-45Supporting role

The Mistress

Juan Peron's lover who Evita sends packing in order to take her place centre stage in Peron's life.

o Belt

Age range: 15-20Supporting role

Ensemble - The People

The Ensemble represents the variety of people of Argentina as Evita makes her rise to power and prestige, most dramatically as The Descamisados – "shirtless ones". There are many and varied smaller solos and cameo roles for the Ensemble – Army Generals, Army Officers, Workers, Aristocrats, Reporters, Lovers, People of Argentina. These range in age from teens to 60 year olds. Men and women of all ages required.

AUDITION PREPARATION

Those auditioning for Principal roles;

- Please prepare a song of your choice from "EVITA" that allows you to show your vocal range and acting ability.
- Please also prepare a **short** monologue that shows your acting ability.

Those auditioning for Ensemble;

• Please prepare a song of your choice that allows you to show your vocal range and acting ability. The song does not have to be from "EVITA". Note: You will need to provide either a backing track or sheet music for your audition if the song is not from "EVITA".

All auditionees - dance/movement:

- There is a lot of dance/movement in "EVITA" and everyone will be required to attend a dance/movement workshop audition on **Sunday, 23 November 2014, at 2.00 p.m.**
- Please wear something appropriate.
- Specialist dancers will be required for several numbers these dancers will also be part of the Ensemble.

Recall auditions will be held on Sunday, 23 November 2014 – time TBA.

- Rehearsals for "EVITA" will commence mid-January 2015.
