

COVID-19 CANCELLATIONS



With the announcement that New Zealand has moved to the 'Red' level of the COVID-19 Protection Framework, ACT THREE PRODUCTIONS have unfortunately had to cancel our production of WE WILL ROCK YOU, which was due to open on 2 February 2022.

We are absolutely heartbroken that this decision has had to be made. This production has been in the making for the last 4-5 years, through two previous cancellations due to COVID-19, and we were so excited to finally see it come to life at the Regent on Broadway. Unfortunately, however, the latest outbreak of Omicron cases just doesn't make that possible.

If you are a ticket holder for the season and you would like a refund, Ticketek will be able to process this and will be in contact in the next week or so. However, it is possible to donate the value of your ticket to assist in recouping unrecoverable costs incurred by ACT THREE PRODUCTIONS in staging this and future productions. We have made the difficult decision to postpone our production of MOANA Jr until 2023. There are a couple of reasons for this.

Firstly; the wellbeing of our cast, crew and production team are very important to us and the unknowns that omicron brings make this very hard to achieve. Secondly; this was our first shot at a large scale production which in turn comes with a large scale budget. As a small theatre company we cannot sustain financial losses.

We will keep moving towards auditions later this year. We will still be holding our normal July School holiday production – audition information will be out soon.

ACT THREE PRODUCTIONS prides itself on being an organisation that puts the health and safety of our community first by encouraging our members and staff to be vaccinated against COVID-19, so that we can reduce the risk of exposure and transmission of COVID-19.

It is important that we provide our staff, members (and visitors) with a safe community in which they can participate in theatre and enjoy our company. A safe community is a COVID-19-free community and currently the best protection against spreading COVID-19 is vaccination.

With the Government's proposed COVID-19 Protection Framework, it is necessary to put this policy in place to allow us to produce shows with audience numbers that will ensure the financial security of our society. Therefore, all ACT THREE PRODUCTIONS events henceforth will require our patrons, staff, members and visitors to be fully vaccinated.

As a condition of entry to our workplace/theatre and events, anyone that enters our venue or events aged 12 and over must provide written or digital evidence of their COVID-19 vaccine certificate, known as **My Vaccine Pass**, to an ACT THREE PRODUCTIONS' representative, on request. Photo ID may also be required to be shown.

Variations to this condition of entry;

- Evidence of a COVID-19 vaccination received other than in New Zealand will be accepted if the evidence is standard in the relevant country and it has been accepted by the Ministry of Health.
- A vaccination exemption has been granted by the Ministry of Health.

ACT THREE PRODUCTIONS reserves the right to restate its position as we learn and understand more about how New Zealand manages the fight against COVID-19 in our communities and workplaces.

This policy came into effect on Thursday, 2 December 2021.
