




# Boy George is returning to Broadway to make Moulin Rouge! even more spectacular

Boy George is gonna swing from the chandelier. The larger-than-life English singer, songwriter, fashion designed and producer will take over the role of the boisterous, top-hatted impresario Harold Zidler in the Tony Award winning musical *Moulin Rouge!* for a limited engagement from 6 February 2024 to 12 May 2024. George is a globally renowned musical icon, known for his soulful voice as well as his penchant for glamorous eye make-up and flamboyant headwear. As the lead singer of the '80s new wave trail-blazers Culture Club, he sang such timeless hits as "Do You Really Want To Hurt Me" and "Karma Chameleon". He is also no stranger to Broadway. The Musical *Taboo*, starring George as Leigh Bowery and loosely based on his life. It opened on Broadway in 2003 and earned him a Tony Award nomination for Best Original Score. Currently he is playing Captain Hook in *Peter Pan: The Arena Spectacular* in the U.K.

#### Huey Lewis and the News musical The Heart of Rock and Roll to open on Broadway

Lewis is no stranger to Broadway, having starred in Chicago as Billy Flynn.

#### A Girls Just Want To Have Fun musical is in the works

A musical adaptation of *Girls Just Want to Have Fun*, the gloriously cheesy 1985 teen comedy starring Sarah Jessica Parker and Helen Hunt is in the works. The show is to be based on the film's screenplay by Amy Spies and will feature a score of '80s hits, including the one made famous by Cyndi Lauper that inspired the title. The music and lyrics will likely be sourced from the catalogue of pop favourites owned by Primary Wave, a private music publishing and talent management company. Primary Wave is home to such beloved '80s artists as Prince, Olivia Newton–John, Boy George and Culture Club, Air Supply and Devo. A story of minor teenage rebellion that's become something of a cult fave for it's '80s time capsule quality, *Girls Just Want to Have Fun* centres on Janey, a talented rule–abiding high school gymnast who moves to a new town and starts disobeying her father. At the encouragement of a wild girl she starts acting out and enters a local TV dance competition.

#### Aaron Tveit and Sutton Foster to take over lead roles in Sweeney Todd

The Tony Award nominated revival of *Sweeney Todd* is welcoming a new pair of stars. Tony winning performers Aaron Tveit and Sutton Foster will take over the roles of Sweeney Todd and Mrs Lovett, respectively, beginning on 9 February 2024 at the Lunt-Fontanne Theatre. Tveit and foster will play a 12 week limited engagement in the revival, through 5 May 2024. They will replace the production's Tony nominated original leads, Josh Groban and Annaleigh Ashford, who will take their final bows on 14 January 2024. Tveit won a Tony for his turn as Christian in *Moulin Rouge! The Musical*. His other Broadway credits include *Catch Me If You Can, Next to Normal, Hairspray* and *Wicked*. Foster, who earned Tonys for *Thoroughly Modern Millie* and *Anything Goes*, was also Tony nominated for turns in *Little Women, The Drowsy Chaperone, Shrek, Violet* and *The Music Man*.

#### The Who's Tommy to receive Broadway revival in 2024

The Who's Tommy will return to Broadway in Spring 2024. Helmed by the musical's original Tony Award winning director Des McAnuff, the revival is described as a reimagined version of the show, which first opened on Broadway in 1993. The Who's Tommy features a Tony winning score by Pete Townshend. The musical is an adaptation of the band The Who's 1969 album of the same name, which – at the time – was described by critics as a rock opera. The Who's Tommy tells the story of Tommy Walker who, as a child, witnesses his father shoot his rival. Tommy turns inward and completely disassociates from the world around him, until his knack for pinball rockets him to celebrity status.

#### Starlight Express extends at the Troubadour Wembley Park Theatre in London

The new London revival of Andrew Lloyd Webber's musical *Starlight Express* is extending its run in London. The show will now be booking through to February 2025. Seen by over 20 million people across the world, *Starlight Express* is back in London from 8 June 2024 at a specially designed "Starlight Auditorium" at Troubadour Wembley Park Theatre. The show promises to be an immersive theatrical event, with a cast of 40 whizzing around and above the audience on special tracks in the specially reconfigured auditorium. Songs in the show, with music by Andrew Lloyd Webber and lyrics by Richard Stilgoe, include "AC/DC", "Make Up My Heart", "Light at the End of the Tunnel" and "Starlight Express". Producer Michael Harrison said in a statement, "Starlight Express is one of the most iconic musicals of the last 40 years, and I am thrilled that our new production has captured imaginations of all ages all over again." *Starlight Express* is now playing in London from 8 June 2024 to 16 February 2025.

A date and venue has been set for the 2024 Tony Awards. The 77<sup>th</sup> annual celebration of Broadway will take place on 16 June 2024 at the David H. Koch Theatre at Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts in New York City.

#### MJ the Musical extends London run to September 2024



The West End production of *MJ The Musical* has extended its run at the Prince Edward Theatre in London. Due to overwhelming demand, Producers of *MJ The Musical* have opened a new three month booking period from 22 June to 14 September 2024, adding three months to the London run. The London production of *MJ The Musical* will see Miles Frost lead the cast, reprising his Tony Award winning role of Michael Jackson. Centred around the making of his 1992 Dangerous World Tour, *MJ The Musical* goes beyond the singular moves and signature sound of the star to offer a rare look at the creative mind and collaborative spirit that catapulted Jackson to legendary status.

## Sister Act The Musical wins London Lifestyle Awards 2023



Sister Act The Musical has won the Theatre Show of the Year award at this year's London Lifestyle Awards 2023. The show was up against a diverse range of productions, including 2:22 A Ghost Story, A Streetcar Named Desire, Dirty Dancing, Guys and Dolls, Legally Blonde, My Neighbour Totoro, My Son's a Queer, SIX The Musical and The Drifters Girl. Winners are chosen by public vote and this year's awards were announced at a ceremony on 30 October 2023. Performers at the show included Tobias Turley, who sang ABBA's "Does Your Mother Know". Tobias is currently competing in ITV's talent show Mamma Mia! I Have a Dream to find a Sky and Sophie for Mamma Mia! in the West End. Other performances at the ceremony included opera star Lucy Kay, and Ben Haenow and his band. Alongside the theatre award, other awards categories included London restaurants, bars and hotels, sport and fitness, cafés and coffee shops, hair and beauty, and members' clubs. CEO Jason Gale, who founded the awards, said; "Huge congratulations to the team behind Sister Act The Musical on their well deserved win. This feel-good gospel hit is a toe-tapping riot, full of heart. It's a testament to the incredible quality of theatre available to audiences in London that the Theatre Show of the year category was so hotly contested. We look forward to welcoming Sister Act back to the capital in Spring 2024!"

#### Jeff Wayne's The War of the Worlds: The Immersive Experience to extend its run in London



Composer and producer Jeff Wayne has agreed with immersive experience specialist Layered Reality to extend the Jeff Wayne's The War of the Worlds: The Immersive Experience in London. The experience will continue playing at London's Leadenhall Street for a further two years, into 2025. Nearly 200,000 people have already visited the multi-million pound attraction, set in 21 rooms over two floors of a building on Leadenhall Street in the City of London. The production is also set to get new music sequences and sound design originated by Jeff Wayne, and The Spirit of Man steampunk bar and restaurant at the venue will also get a new light and sound show. At the experience, visitors travel back to 1898 and experience escaping a Martian-occupied Victorian England, in an action-packed journey based on the classic HG Wells story The War of The Worlds, and set to Jeff Wayne's iconic score. Layered Reality uses a mix of live actors, movie quality sets, virtual reality (VR), digital tech and multi-sensory effects to create the complete experience. Composer and Producer Jeff Wayne said in a statement; "In June of this year, we announced that The War of The Worlds: The Immersive Experience would be relocating to a new venue and featuring an updated production. However, soon after our announcement, we had the wonderful and unexpected opportunity to remain at Leadenhall Street for a further two years, which we couldn't say 'no' to. And we're thrilled that new and returning audiences will have the chance to see this updated award-winning experience for more years to come. Originally planned for a three month run, here we are, almost five years later, and heading for seven! No one would have believed! Layered Reality are recognised leaders in creating unrivalled immersive experiences, and we are delighted to continue working with them." CEO of Layered Reality Andrew McGuinness said; "Our focus remains on delivering for our customers and as we take the experience to the next level alongside our partner Jeff Wayne, we will be making enhancements to the experience over the coming weeks to ensure it continues to exceed quest expectations. Jeff Wayne is an incredible composer and producer and our close working partnership has been fundamental to the success of Jeff Wayne's The War of The Worlds: The Immersive Experience. We are looking forward to continuing our work with him and learning from his years of expertise to create a truly unique memory-making experience."

## Royal Variety Performance 2023 performers revealed ...



The Royal Variety Charity has announced performers for its annual *Royal Variety Performance*. The 2023 event will take place at the Royal Albert Hall on 30 November 2023. The show will feature lots of West End performers and shows this year, including a major tribute marking 100 years of Disney, including the casts of *The Lion King, Frozen The Musical, Aladdin, Hercules* and *Beauty & The Beast*.

West End and Ted Lasso star Hannah Waddingham will perform with the English National Opera chorus and classical pianist Lang Lang will play a duet with the 14-year-old winner of Channel 4's talent show The Piano, Lucy. There will also be performances from brand new British musical *The Little Big Things*, now playing at @sohoplace theatre in the West End; along with smash-hit Gershwin musical *Crazy For You*, now playing at the Gillian Lynne Theatre; and the cast of *Sister Act* led by Beverley Knight – coming to the Dominion Theatre next year. Spice Girl and actor Melanie Chisholm will lead a tribute to theatre producer Bill Kenwright who died recently, aged 78. Chisholm starred in one of Kenwright's most successful shows, *Blood Brothers*, in the West End.

Derren Brown's West End show *Unbelievable*, now playing at the Criterion Theatre in London, will be the magic act on the night; plus Argentinian dance show *Malevo* – which is now playing at the Peacock Theatre – will perform. Producers of *The Little Big Things*, Michael Harrison and Nica Burns said in a statement; "It is such an honour for *The Little Big Things*, our brand new musical, created by a first time British writing team, to be invited to perform on such an iconic show. We and the whole company are absolutely delighted." Superstar Cher, Rick Astley, Zara Larsson, McFly and Paloma Faith will also sing during the night, and comedians will include Britain's Got Talent winner Viggo Venn, plus Tom Allen, Rosie Jones, Ellie Taylor and Simon Brodkin.

The National Anthem will be led by The Fanfare Trumpeters of The Band of the Welsh Guards and the National Youth Choir. Host Bradley Walsh said in a statement; "I am so excited to be presenting this year's show. It's been 30 years this year since I first performed at The Royal Variety Performance, so what an absolute honour to be hosting. The line-up is incredible and I can't wait for you all to see what I have in store." Last year's show included performances from Andrew Lloyd Webber, Gary Barlow, *Cabaret* and *Newsies*. The Royal Variety Performance is attended by members of the royal family, and will air on ITVI in December, with the date to be confirmed.
